

RESOLUTION NO. 84-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF RANCHO MURIETA
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT. ADEQUACY OF EXISTING
WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Rancho Murieta Community Services District
provided water, sewer, and drainage services to the residents
and lands within the District, and

WHEREAS, the existing water treatment facilities have
adequate capacity to serve approximately 1250 residential
customers; and

WHEREAS, the District is serving approximately 500
residential customers at this time; and

WHEREAS, the presently developed lots within the District
when fully occupied will total over 1500 residential customers;
and

WHEREAS, plans are being considered for development of the
next unit of subdivision which will further increase the
potential number of residential customers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT:


That the Board of Directors expresses its concerns to
potential developers and appropriate Sacramento County
regulatory and permitting agencies to advise them of the need
for increased water treatment and ancillary water facilities
concurrent with the development of the next unit of subdivision
at Rancho Murieta.


