

**RESOLUTION 2010-13**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
AMENDING FIXED EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION FOR UNREPRESENTED  
PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District has heretofore adopted Resolution No. 84-9 establishing a Fixed Employer's Contribution for Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District amended the Employer's Contribution amount for said Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act in 1999 by adopting Resolution 99-8;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District amended the Employer's Contribution amount for said Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act in 2004 by adopting Resolution 2004-21;

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 22892(a) provides that a local agency contracting under the Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act shall fix the amount of the employer's contribution at an amount not less than the amount required under Section 22892(b)(1) of the Act; and

**WHEREAS**, Rancho Murieta Community Services District has fully complied with any and all applicable provisions of Government Code Section 7507 in electing the benefit set forth above; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District last amended the Employer's Contribution amount for said Public Employee's Medical and Hospital Care Act in 2009 by adopting Resolution 2009-07;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District resolves that the section of Resolution 2009-07, describing the Employer's Contribution, shall be amended to read as follows:

- B. The employer's contribution for unrepresented employees or annuitants shall be the amount necessary to pay the full costs of his/her enrollment, including the enrollment of his/her family member(s), based on the lowest HMO – Sacramento region basic, plus administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund assessments. The change is effective January 1, 2011 and is reviewed periodically by the Board.


