

RESOLUTION NO. 84-7

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF ELECTION - JUNE 5, 1984.

WHEREAS, an election was held within the Rancho Murieta Community Services District on June 5, 1984 submitting to voters the question of whether the district should adopt additional powers for the purposes of providing fire protection service; ambulance service; garbage or refuse collection or disposal; mosquito abatement; library service; construction and improvement of bridges, culverts, curbs, gutters, drains, and works incidental to road construction and maintenance; conversion of existing overhead and electric communication facilities to underground locations; public airports and landing places for aerial traffic; and transportation service; and

WHEREAS, Section 17111 of the Elections Code of the State of California requires that the governing Board declare the results of the election; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Voter Registration and Elections of the County of Sacramento has provided a Statement of the Vote for the Primary Election held on June 5, 1984.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The Board of Directors declares that the results of the Primary Election held on June 5, 1984 is as follows:

Total Voters - 711; Total Votes Cast - 435

Measure B: Proposed Authorization of Additional Powers for Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Yes - 379; No - 42; Blank Votes/Ballots - 14; Other Votes/Ballots 0.




