### OPERATIONS

In July and August there have been **seven (7) DUI arrests** in Rancho Murieta. Four (4) in the North residential area, one (1) on Jackson Road near the bridge, one (1) on Jackson Road at Stonehouse Road, and one (1) on the Stonehouse Road/Latrobe Road area. Of these arrests, three (3) were residents and three (3) were guests of residents.

Security Patrol Officers responded to 14 snake calls in August. Of those 14 calls, 13 were for rattlesnakes. As always, be aware of your surroundings.

Summerfest was well attended again this year. The North Gate was very busy on Saturday, checking in guests and vendors. There was a report of an altercation at the park late Saturday night between two young adults, but the weekend event was otherwise quiet.

### INCIDENTS OF NOTE

August 1, Sunday, 8:25 p.m., Lobo Drive. Multiple calls were made regarding a verbal and possible physical altercation between a male and female. Callers were referred to 911. Sacramento Sheriff's Department (SSD) responded.

August 9, Monday, 1:30 a.m., Camino Del Lago. While notifying a resident of her son's curfew violation, the resident appeared intoxicated and was belligerent and uncooperative. She drove away from the house and returned. SSD and California Highway Patrol (CHP) responded. She was arrested for DUI.

August 9, Monday, 12:30 p.m., De La Cruz. A window was shot with a BB.

August 10, Tuesday, 3:00 a.m., Murieta Parkway near Domingo Drive. Several reports of yelling and profanity, area check found three (3) males with bats. SSD & CHP notified and responded. Arguing over female resident, two (2) guests arrested for DUI and public intoxication. Both under 21 years of age, parents notified.

August 12, Thursday, 10:37 p.m., Lago Drive. SSD responded to a report of domestic violence. Mediated.

August 13, Friday, 12:19 a.m., Guadalupe Drive. Occupied vehicle with three (3) juveniles and a strong odor of marijuana, parents notified.

August 13, Friday, 5:18 p.m., Jackson Road east of bridge. Two (2) car accident with one (1) rollover. Mother and 3 ½ year old transported with minor injuries, other driver not injured but arrested by CHP for DUI. Security Patrol Officers provided traffic control.

August 19, Thursday, 10:38 a.m., Country Store reports that a lock on the vacuum cleaner has been broken twice in the last three (3) weeks. The locked door is the dust/dirt clean-out.

August 21, Saturday, 10:30 p.m., Murieta Parkway at Alameda Drive. Non-injury rear end collision. Resident driver was arrested by CHP for DUI.

August 24, Tuesday, 9:48 p.m., Country Club. An intoxicated resident insisted on driving his golf cart home, refusing to allow his wife to drive. Security Patrol Officer responded and convinced him to allow his wife to drive him home.

August 28, Saturday, 11:10 pm., Stonehouse Park. Off-Duty SSD Deputy working for CSD requested medical assistance for a reported head injury due to an altercation between two young adults. One of the subjects left the area. No transport or further action.

August 28, Saturday, 1:17 a.m., Stonehouse Road at Jackson Road. Driver ran the stop sign at Stonehouse Road and Jackson Road, colliding with the light pole on the south side of Jackson Road. Both occupants had been drinking and were transported to the hospital. Driver arrested by CHP for DUI. The vehicle had earlier been checked in as a guest of a resident.

The Security Department received various calls regarding unruly juveniles, loud music and parties, and toilet paper jobs.
