Marion, to update you as to the status of the above referenced easements, the following is an outline of our findings and recommendations as of December 2, 1992.

FINDINGS:

Vail Engineering is currently preparing the detention basin easement and the sewer easement which will encumber the Geyer property. Conversations with Jeff Thompson of Vail indicate that there is a strong possibility that the easements will not be finalized in time for the December Board Meeting.

Founders Title Company is preparing the CIA easement which will encumber the Geyer property. It has been brought to Staff's attention that the CIA's legal counsel will be required to review the easement documents prior to presentation for CIA action. CIA will then need to prepare a resolution accepting the easement.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

In light of Mr. Geyer's need for all three easements to be recorded this year, together with the likelihood of those easements not being finalized in time for the December Board Meeting; it is our recommendation that the Board approve a resolution accepting the detention basin and sewer easements and authorizing the Board President to sign the resolution to accept these easements for recordation subject to final review by the District's Engineering and Legal Departments.

In the mean time, we will continue to assist in the expedition of these preparation of these easements and coordinate accordingly with CIA's legal counsel, Vail Engineering and the respective Title Companies.
