

ORDINANCE 2002-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING CHAPTER 21, SECTION 7.06 (d) OF THE DISTRICT SECURITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

This Ordinance is based on the authority of Government Code sections 61621.5, 61622 and 831.8 and Penal Code section 836.5.

SECTION TWO:

Chapter 21 of the District Security Code, Section 7.06 is amended, by the addition of the following:

7.06

(d) **Prohibited Presence on District Property**

No person(s) except District employees and persons expressly authorized by the District Manager shall go upon or remain upon any property of the District that has been posted "entry prohibited" or "no trespassing" at the direction of the District Board of Directors.

(1) **Violation of Prohibited Entry Designation**

Pursuant to Government Code, section 61621.5, any person who willfully violates Section 7.06 (d) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

(2) **Authority to Arrest and Cite**

Security officers of the District designated by the District Manager shall have the authority and immunities of public officers and employees set Section 836.5 of the Penal Code to make arrests and issue citations in accordance with the provisions of chapter 5C (commencing with Section 853.6), Title 3, Part 2 of the Penal Code, for misdemeanor violations of the laws of the State of California and ordinances of the County of Sacramento and the District, committed within their presence within the boundaries of the District.

SECTION THREE:

To the extent the terms and conditions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules or regulations, the terms and provisions thereof, and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations are hereby repealed.

If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, no other provision of this ordinance shall be affected thereby.

SECTION FOUR:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after adoption.




