WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 23302 requires the District to file with the Board of Supervisors, and a copy with the Registrar of Voters, a resolution requesting consolidation with a statewide election.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rancho Murieta Community Services District requests the Board of Supervisors of Sacramento County to consolidate the regularly scheduled District election with the statewide general election to be held on November 8, 1988; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the candidate is to pay for the publication of the candidate's statement, pursuant to Election Code Section 10012. The limitation on the number of words that a candidate may use in his/her candidate's statement is 200 words; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Rancho Murieta Community Services District agrees to reimburse the Registrar of Voters for actual costs accrued for each election, such costs to be calculated by proration method set forth in the County's current Election Cost Allocation Procedures on the basis of the amount of services provided to the Rancho Murieta Community Services District.

PUBLICATION OF NOTICE(S) OF ELECTION

Elections Code Section 23511 states: "At least 90 days, and not more than 120 days, before the day fixed for the general district election the Registrar of Voters of the principal county shall publish a notice of the election once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the district or, if no such newspaper is published in the district, in a newspaper having general circulation in the district published in any affected county in the district. The notice shall contain the date of the general district election, name the offices for which candidates may file, and state the qualifications required by the principal act for each office. The notice shall state the location where official declarations of candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for any of the elective offices may be obtained. The notice shall state that appointment to each elective office will be made as prescribed by Section 23520 in the event there are no nominees or an insufficient number of nominees for such office and a petition for an election is not filed wihtin the time period prescribed by Section 23520."
