

Rancho Murieta Golf Cart/NEV Circulation Plan

Rules for Golf Cart/NEV Crossing Highway 16

Effective January 1, 2007

Golf carts and Neighborhood Electric Vehicles (NEV) intended for travel across Highway 16 are required to meet applicable federal and state requirements to operate on a state or public roadway.

Golf carts and NEVs operated pursuant to CVC 345 shall conform to the applicable minimum safety equipment as specified below. The minimum safety equipment required differs depending whether golf carts/NEVs are used during daylight or after dusk. The **minimum safety equipment requirements** are as follows:

<u>Daylight</u>	<u>After Dusk</u>
Stop Lamp	Stop Lamp
One Rear Reflector	One Rear Reflector
Horn	Horn
	Head Lamp
	Tail Lamp

Golf carts may be additionally equipped with the following safety features:

Rear View Mirror	Parking Brake (standard Equipment)
Seatbelts	Front and Rear Turn Signal Lights
Windshield	

In addition to the above minimum safety criteria, **operators must also possess a valid driver's license.**

In addition to the above equipment requirements, golf carts and NEVs may not be operated in an unsafe condition, which is not equipped as required by the California Vehicle Code, or which is not safely loaded. (CVC 24002)

Note: The above standards do not apply to golf carts used exclusively for normal play on the golf course or within the residential area of Rancho Murieta North or Rancho Murieta South and that are not intended for travel across Highway 16.
