

RESOLUTION NO. 83- 3

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF ELECTION - MARCH 8, 1983

WHEREAS, an election was held within the Rancho Murieta Community Services District on March 8, 1983 submitting to voters the question of whether the District should adopt additional powers for the purposes of (a) providing water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation, industrial use, fire protection, and recreation; (b) providing for the collection, treatment, or disposal of sewage of the District and its inhabitants; and (c) providing for the collection, treatment or disposal of waste and storm water of the District and its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, Section 17111 of the Elections Code of the State of California requires that the governing Board declare the results of the election; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Voter Registration and Elections of the County of Sacramento has provided a Statement of the Vote for the Special Election held on March 8, 1983.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The Board of Directors declares that the results of the Special Election held on March 8, 1983 is as follows:

Total Voters 611; Precinct Vote 282; Absentee Votes 21;
Total Vote 303.

Measure A: Proposed Authorization of Additional Powers for District, Yes 195; No 108; Blank Votes/Ballots 0; Other Votes/Ballots 0.

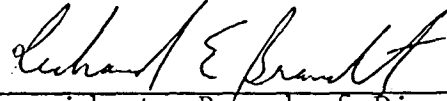
