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## What's New on the Local Solid Waste Front?

- **AB1826- Commercial Organic Waste (Food/Green).**  
Large Generators by April 2016; step downs in generator sizes in following years.  
**Local Impact:** Eventually will include Residential Food Waste Collection Programs that will increase tip fees causing rise in residential rates.
- **AB1594- Greenwaste as Alternative Daily Cover.**  
Current practice ends on January 1, 2020.  
**Local Impact:** New programs and facilities will increase tip fees causing rise in residential rates.
