A RESOLUTION OF THE  
RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
ELECTING CSDA WORKERS COMPENSATION PROGRAM


WHEREAS the Board of Directors of this district desires to discontinue its workers' compensation insurance coverage through State Compensation Insurance Fund and to become self-insured for workers' compensation benefits through membership in Program CSDA, a Joint Powers Authority administrated by the California Special Districts Association.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:


- (1) That this district discontinue its workers' compensation coverage through State Compensation Insurance Fund as of July 1, 1990, and become self-insured through Program CSDA as of that date.
- (2) That this district sign the Joint Powers Agreement with Program CSDA and file an Application for Consent to Self-Insure with the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California.
- (3) That Marion C. Cravens as the General Manager of this district is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of this district to sign all documents and to take all actions that may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Resolution.
