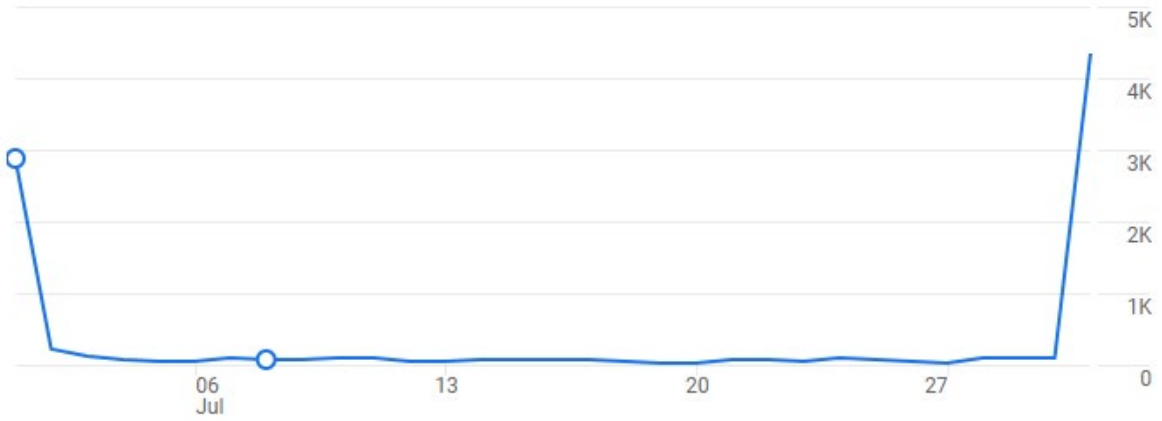

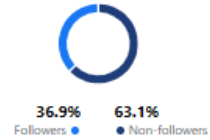

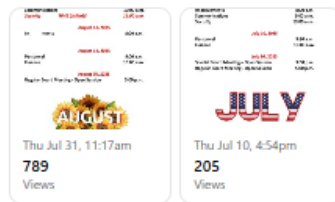


By followers vs non-followers

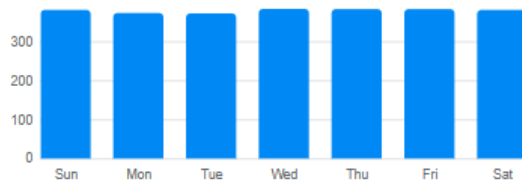

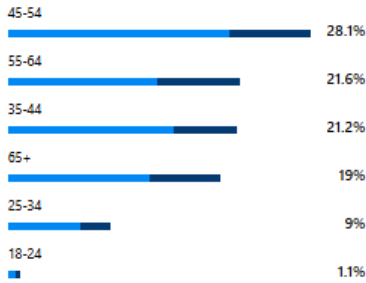

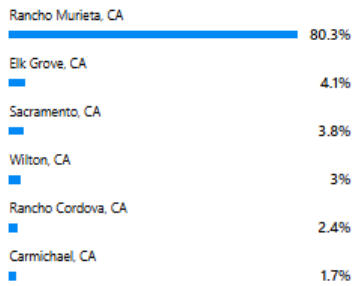

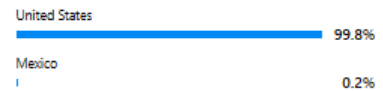
