

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**December 1-30, 2021**

**December 3, 2021: Traffic accident Riverview Cart Path:**

CSD security officer responded to the scene of a traffic accident between two golf carts. One party advised the CSD officer that he suspected the other party of being under the influence of alcohol. CSD security officer advised both parties that the CHP was dispatched, and they should wait for their arrival. The suspected DUI driver refused to stay and left the area with friends, leaving behind his golf cart which was disabled in the accident. CHP arrived and investigated the incident and conducted a follow-up to the suspects residence.

**December 7, 2021: Vandalism in Bel Air bathroom.**

An employee conducted a routine restroom inspection and discovered tagging marks on the restroom doors with a paint pen. SSD was notified and a report was generated, security cameras observed a couple of juveniles enter the rest room shortly before the employee's inspection. **Note:** Tagging marks are identical to new vandalism on 01/05/2022 on yellow bridge, 6B lift station and wooden bridge. Working with SSD/RMA to help ID the suspects.

**December 17, 2021 1000 hours: Battery Investigation Jackson Rd and Parkway RM.**

CSD Security responded to a possible traffic accident. Upon the officer's arrival he discovered two citizens were detained at gunpoint by an off-duty SSD and retired SF police officer. The officers provided identification to our responding security officer and stated the two civilians had been involved in a battery scenario and were detained. SSD arrived on scene and conducted their investigation and completed a report.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**January 1-31, 2022**

**January 5, 2022: Vandalism (Inside of North)**

CSD Security officer responded to the Yellow Bridge and 6B Lift Station, white pen graffiti was used on property, photographs obtained and SSD notified. Possible related to Bel Air graffiti incident. CSD spoke with Parents.

**January 5, 2022: Burglary Petty Theft: Plaza shopping Center (Outside of gates)**

CSD Security responded to a shoplift incident at Ace Hardware, suspect stole two window breaking devices valued at 30 dollars. Suspect left the store and proceeded to the Murieta health club and stole a set of keys from the gym. The suspect had the stolen keys and located the victim's vehicle. The suspect removed the victim's credits cards from the vehicle. The suspect then charged \$900.00 at Costco in Rancho Cordova. SSD was notified and video footage of the suspect was provided to SSD.

**January 9, 2022: Burglary occurred on Via Sereno Drive (Inside North)**

CSD Security Responded to a burglary investigation. Suspect(s) entered the victim's garage and removed a battery from his Rav 4 truck. The victim left his garage door unsecure and believes the suspect(s) took advantage of the fact. SSD was contact and a report was filed. No camera or additional witnesses could be located. Victims loss \$250.00.

**January 5, 2022: Grand Theft occurred at Cantova Drive-Anderson Field (Outside Gates).**

CSD Security responded to a report of a theft of metal building sidings. Suspect(s) drove their flatbed tuck to the location and removed the siding and fled the location. The suspect(s) were captured via CSD and victims video camera equipment. SSD was notified and the suspect(s) were identified, and an arrest warrant was issued. Victims Loss \$5,000.00.

**January 23, 2022: Burglary occurred at Backyard Restaurant, (Outside Gates).**

CSD responded to a follow-up investigation to obtain video footage. Suspect(s) entered the location via roof and removed a safe and DVR from the location. SSD responded and completed a report. Victims Loss \$2,000.00.

**January 23, 2022: Grand Theft Motor vehicle, Bel Air Grocery Store (Outside Gates)**

CSD not involved however, CHP requested video footage from Southgate. Suspect(s) used their vehicle to steal a trailer with a golf cart attached to the trailer.

**January 23, 2022: Vandalism at Stonehouse Park (Inside North)**

CSD Security responded to a call of tire marks left on the soccer field. Suspect(s) entered the Stonehouse park and drove their vehicle on the soccer and baseball fields and fled the area. No camera coverage of the incident SSD notified.

**January 25, 2022: Attempted Burglary at Go4Pizza (Outside Gates).**

CSD Security responded and notified SSD for the victim. Suspect(s) broke off locks to storage unit in the rear. Suspect(s) entered the location however, nothing was removed. No video footage or witnesses to incident.

**January 25, 2022: Grand Theft at the Village (Outside Gates).**

CSD Security responded to assist the victim with notifying CHP of the theft. No video footage was recovered of the incident. The victim believed a universal key was used in the theft.

Victims Loss \$2000.00.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE  
FEBRUARY 1-28, 2022**

**February 10, 2022: at 2230 hours; Threats to others (OE3 School)**

CSD Security officer responded to assist with the removal of a student from the OE3 school. Upon arrival CSD staff met with OE3 Security Officer. The student had made verbal threats towards both security officers and he mentioned a firearm. SSD responded and placed the student on a 5150 hold per WIC and was transported. There were no firearms discovered by SSD. Student was expelled from the OE3 school.

**February 14, 2022, 0200 hours: DUI/Property Damage (North)**

CSD Security responded to a traffic accident between One park and Two Parks. Upon arrival CSD Security observed a single vehicle accident. A fire hydrant and mailbox unit were laying on the ground and the suspect was on scene. Notifications to CHP, RMA and CSD were completed by CSD Security. The CHP investigated and placed the suspect under arrest for 23152(a) VC and completed a report. CSD has copy of CHP report. Property damage unknown currently.

**February 17, 2022, Midnight-0600 hours: Burglary from vehicle (North) Camino Del Lago**

CSD Security was on routine patrol when a citizen flagged him down. The victim stated that his vehicle was broken into and his power tools was removed during the night. The victim stated that his rear window was left open and opined that is how the suspect made entry. Victims loss was \$3500.00, SSD was notified and a report was generated.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**March 1-31, 2022**

**March 1-2, 2022, Burglary between 0200-1500 hours (North)**

CSD Security responded to an address on Anillo Way. A citizen reported that an unknown person broke into their home and removed a toolbox with various tools. The point of entry was the side garage door that was used to enter the house. The total loss to the victim was approximately \$500.00. SSD was notified and there was a report generated.

**March 21, 2022, Stolen/recovered trailer at approximately 0850 hours. (Outside Gates)** CSD security was contacted by SSD and advised that a stolen trailer was located behind the plaza and was being recorded by CHP. The victim (Owner) had tracked the stolen trailer with GPS. CHP released the stolen trailer minus the tractor that was inside the trailer to the victim.

**March 23, 2022, Stolen Vehicle 1850 hours, Chevron Gas Station (Outside Gates)**

CSD security staff was informed by the victim that she was that her motorcycle was stolen. The suspect a Rancho Murieta juvenile met the victim at the gas station to purchase the victim's motorcycle. The victim agreed to let the suspect test drive the bike. The suspect rode the motorcycle back into RM North and did not return the motorbike. CSD security cameras captured the incident and were able to ID the suspect. CHP was notified and they conducted a follow-up investigation. The motorcycle was returned to the owner and the suspect was issued a citation.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**April 1-30, 2022**

**April 10<sup>th</sup> at approximately 1940 hours, Theft from Vehicle, Lake Calero (North)**

CSD Security was contacted at the Northgate at which time the victim stated a canvased painting was stolen from his unsecured vehicle when he was walking around the lake. The victim didn't see any suspects however, observed a blue truck in the area. The victim contacted the SSD and made the theft report, value unknown.

**April 15<sup>th</sup> approximately 2100 hours, Vehicle/Vandalism, Via Sereno (North)**

CSD Security responded to a call for service. The reporting person (RP) stated that she and her husband heard a loud popping noise outside on the street. The husband was sent to investigate and discovered his neighbor's vehicle window was shattered. The neighbor was not at home during the vandalism. CSD responded and canvased the area for video coverage and evidence with negative results. The victim's daughter was contacted and advised to make a report with the SSD.

**April 24<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 2100 hours, Loud Noise Complaint, Murieta Parkway (North)**

CSD security personnel responded to a loud noise complaint. Upon arrival, the officer discovered a male outside the residence agitated and throwing something in the driveway. The officer relocated his position and called the SSD to respond to a domestic dispute. SSD arrived and informed CSD security the incident was a minor verbal argument.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**May 1- 25<sup>th</sup>**

**May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 at approximately 1414 hours, Suspicious Activity Equestrian Center (Outside Gates)**

CSD Security was contacted regarding an individual driving around the area and peeking into vehicles parked at the Equestrian Center. The possible suspect was driving a Gray Kia Sport license number (XXX). The PR shouted at the individual and he fled the area W/B on Jackson. CSD security obtained the vehicle's license plate and turned it over to SSD.

**May 13<sup>th</sup>, 1635 hours, Theft Airport Storage reported, Occurred between December 2021-May 2022, (Outside Gate)**

The victim was advised by the manager of the storage area that his catalytic converter was stolen. The victim has not checked his vehicle for 6 months and therefore didn't have the exact time of the theft. SSD was notified and a report was generated. An unknown value of property loss.

**May 08, 2022, at 1927 hours, Vandalism at Riverview Park Bathrooms (South)**

CSD Security on routine patrol discovered the bathroom has been marked with black paint or markers. Several pictures were taken, and RMA was advised of the damage. RMA compliance officers were investigating.

**May 13, 2022, at 1745 hours, Vandalism at North Gazebo Bathroom (North)**

CSD Security on routine patrol discovered the men's restroom walls had been marked with various statements. RMA was notified and compliance officers are currently investigating. The instrument used was most likely a black sharpie marker.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**June 1 - 30<sup>th</sup>**

**On June 6<sup>th</sup> 2022 at approximately 10:30 hours, Hate Incident Graffiti- Gazebo area parking lot, Northgate area.**

CSD security responded to a vandalism call at the Gazebo area located next to the Northgate. Upon arrival, CSD staff observed several swastikas and a drawing of male genitalia along with the statement "Heil Hitler" located on the driveway adjacent to the playground area. SSD and RMA were immediately advised to respond to the location.

Two male juveniles (6<sup>th</sup> grade) were playing in the area and came over and asked about CSD investigation. Both juveniles stated that they knew the graffiti was wrong but didn't know exactly why. Both juveniles resumed playing in the area. CSD officer proceeded to the Northgate and met with RMA Compliance Officer (CO) who located the video surveillance footage of the incident.

The Juveniles walked over to the Northgate unsolicited and stated they might know who did the vandalism. CSD staff asked to them watch the video before making any statements. Juvenile-1 stated that his older brother was in the video along with several of his brother's friends. The parents were contacted, and all parties were identified and turned over to SSD and RMA for ongoing vandalism investigations. (Parents met with CSD staff over the incident and received an apology letter from the juveniles involved).

**On June 7, 2022, at approximately 1830 hours, Intoxicated person in Lake Calero**

CSD personnel was on routine patrol when they discovered a male fully clothed swimming in Lake Calero. CSD Personnel contacted the male and ordered him out of the lake. The male complied and was advised of the swimming rules. The male stated the trees were talking to him and that he felt that he was on fire, and again ran into the lake. The male stayed in the lake for approximately 30 minutes about 20 yards away from the shore, until he was convinced to exit the lake by CSD staff. Upon his exit, CSD security took custody of the male and detained him due to his intoxication and fear of drowning. SSD eventually arrived on the scene and took custody of the resident.

## **INCIDENTS OF NOTE**

### **July 1-31, 2022**

#### **On July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at approximately 00:15 hours, Vandalism/Reckless Driving.**

CSD security responded to several reports of a truck driving recklessly in the South. Several neighbors were awakened by the loud squealing wheels. CSD gate officer observed a white truck had left via the south gate and then immediately wanted to re-enter via the south gate, shortly after receiving the numerous calls of a reckless vehicle. CSD Gate Officer refused to let the vehicle into the community and formed the opinion the truck with the three males was involved in the original calls for service and they were possibly under the influence of alcohol.

The driver put his vehicle in reverse hit a sign and drove over the grass median area and fled W/B on Jackson. The truck fled to a resident's house in the Garden Community. CSD Security officer was on scene and witnessed (3) males exit the vehicle and hop a fence into the backyard. CSD security officer asked one of the males what they were doing, and he stated they lived there.

CSD Security monitored the area for several minutes and noticed that one of the males had removed the license plate from the vehicle they parked. SSD and CHP refused to respond since all parties were GOA.

On July 26<sup>th</sup>, CSD staff conducted a follow-up investigation and identified all parties involved. The male driver who does not live in RM was a guest of a Retreat resident. The other passenger lived in South RM. All were over 18 Years Old. The owners of the Retreat resident and their son who allowed the driver to enter came to CSD for an interview. During the interview with CSD staff, their son admitted that his friend drove recklessly and damaged RMA's grass and sign. The son denied that any party was under the influence, and they fled to their friend's house in the gardens because they believed CSD were police who would arrest them. The son stated his friend would be more than happy to pay for any damages.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**AUGUST 1-31, 2022**

ON THURSDAY, 08/11/2022, AT ABOUT 1745 HOURS, CSD SECURITY OFFICERS, WERE DISPATCHED TO REYNOSO DRIVE, CONCERNING AN INCIDENT INVOLVING AN ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON INVESTIGATION.

CSD SECURITY OFFICERS CONTACTED VICTIMS 1 AND 2, WHO WERE STANDING IN THEIR DRIVEWAY WHEN THEY EXITED THEIR PATROL VEHICLE. VICTIM- 1 STATED THE INCIDENT FIRST OCCURRED ON JACKSON HIGHWAY WHEN HE WAS INVOLVED WHEN A ROAD RAGE INCIDENT WHILE A FEMALE DRIVING AN AUDI. THE AUDI FOLLOWED VICITM-1 HOME TO RM SOUTH.

VICTIM-1 ARRIVED HOME, THE GREY AUDI DROVE SLOWLY BY HIS HOME. VICTIM-1 STATED HE FELT THREATENED THAT SOMEONE FOLLOWED HIM TO HIS RESIDENCE AND GOT BACK IN HIS VEHICLE AND CHASED THE AUDI DOWN THE STREET ON REYNOSO DRIVE, TOWARDS MURIETA SOUTH PARKWAY. VICTIM-1 CAUGHT UP TO THE AUDI AND BEGAN TO HAVE A VERBAL ALTERCATION WITH THE FEMALE DRIVER.

DURING THE VERBAL ARGUMENT, AN UNKNOWN, WHITE, MALE, ADULT, DRIVING A DARK BLUE GOLF CART, WITH TAN SEATS, WITH A SEVEN- OR EIGHT-YEAR CHILD, APPROACHED THE AREA. THE UNKNOWN, MALE BECAME INVOLVED IN THE VERBAL CONFRONTATION, WHICH WAS TAKING PLACE BETWEEN VICTIM-1 AND THE FEMALE DRIVER OF THE AUDI.

V-1 STATED DURING THE ARGUMENT THE UNKNOWN, MALE WHO APPEARED TO BE INTOXICATED, RAISED A BEER BOTTLE IN A THREATENING MANNER TOWARD VICTIM-1. VICTIM-1 RESPONDED BY BRANDISHING A KNIFE THAT HE HAD IN HIS POCKET AND CHALLENGING THE UNKNOWN, MALE. VICTIM-1 DECIDED TO RETURN TO HIS RESIDENCE AND LEAVE THE AREA, VICTIM-1 STATED THE UNKNOWN MALE MADE A SPONTANEOUS STATEMENT, " I KNOW WHERE YOU LIVE."

APPROXIMATELY TEN MINUTES LATER, THE UNKNOWN, MALE RETURNED TO VICTIM-1 RESIDENCE, DRIVING A WHITE, TOYOTA, TUNDRA PICKUP TRUCK. VICTIM-1 AND HIS GIRLFRIEND VICTIM-2 WERE STANDING IN THEIR DRIVEWAY, IN FRONT OF THEIR OPEN GARAGE. ANOTHER VERBAL ARGUMENT ENSUED, IN WHICH THE UNKNOWN, MALE WITHDREW A BLACK, SEMIAUTOMATIC HANDGUN, AND FIRED ONE ROUND FROM THE DRIVER'S SEAT, TOWARDS VICTIM 1 AND 2. THE UNKNOWN MALE FLED THE LOCATION AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED, TOWARDS SOUTH MURIETA PARKWAY. SSD RESPONDED AND THE CASE IS ACTIVELY ONGOING.

**INCIDENTS OF NOTE**  
**September 1-30, 2022**

\*ON TUESDAY, 09/13/2022, AT ABOUT 0830 HOURS, CSD STAFF WAS CONDUCTING PATROL IN THE ALLEY BEHIND THE MURIETA BUSINESS PLAZA. CSD SECURITY WAS APPROACHED BY ACE HARDWARE EMPLOYEE.

THE EMPLOYEE STATED THAT AROUND 0530 HOURS IN THE MORNING, HE WITNESSED AN UNKNOWN MALE ADULT, BACK UP HIS BLACK, CHEVROLET TRUCK, TO ONE OF THE BUILDINGS. THE EMPLOYEE WITNESSED THE UNKNOWN MALE ADULT, START TO UNLOAD SOME LARGE CAR PARTS, WHICH CONSISTED OF A CAR DOOR, AND TAILGATE, AND PLACE THE ITEMS AGAINST THE BUILDING WALL.

THE EMPLOYEE WAS ABLE TO CAPTURE PHOTOS OF THE TRUCK, LICENSE PLATE, AND ITEMS DISCARDED. THE SUSPECT SAW HE WAS BEING WATCHED, PUT THE ITEMS BACK IN HIS TRUCK, AND DROVE AWAY WITHOUT INCIDENT. CSD SECURITY STAFF CONDUCTED A FOLLOW-UP VISITATION WITH THE RM-NORTH RESIDENT AND ADVISED HIM THAT ILLEGAL DUMPING WAS AGAINST THE LAW AND SSD WOULD BE NOTIFIED.

\*ON WEDNESDAY 09/21/2022, AT AROUND 0728 HOURS, CSD DISPATCH WAS CONTACTED BY POSTMASTER, CONCERNING A THEFT AND VANDALISM TO ONE OF THE POST OFFICE VEHICLES.

CSD PATROL ARRIVED AT THE SCENE OF THE REPORTED INCIDENT AT ABOUT 0740 HOURS. CSD PATROL OBSERVED A FUEL LEAK FROM UNDERNEATH A VAN. THE EVIDENCE SUGGESTED THAT A SUSPECT DRILLED A HOLE INTO THE BOTTOM OF THE FUEL TANK. IT APPEARED THE INCIDENT OCCURRED BETWEEN 0700 HOURS AND 0720 HOURS, BECAUSE CSD PATROL CONDUCTED A CHECK EARLIER, BETWEEN 0616 HOURS AND 0618 HOURS. SSD WAS NOTIFIED AND A REPORT WAS TAKEN, AN UNKNOWN AMOUNT OF LOSS.

\*ON THURSDAY 09/22/2022 AT 1509 HOURS, CSD SECURITY WAS DISPATCHED TO A RESIDENCE ON MEDELLA CIRCLE TO CONDUCT A WELFARE CHECK. UPON ARRIVAL THE CSD OFFICER NOTICED A STRONG ODOR EMERGING FROM THE RESIDENCE AND A LARGE NUMBER OF INSECTS INSIDE THE LOCATION. CSD DISPATCH THEN NOTIFIED SSD AND THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO RESPOND TO ASSIST WITH THE INVESTIGATION. METRO FIRE UNIT 59 ARRIVED AND MADE ENTRY INTO THE LOCATION AND DISCOVERED A DECEASED INDIVIDUAL. THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY CORONERS' OFFICE RESPONDED AND COMPLETED THE INVESTIGATION.
