NOTICE INVITING BIDS
FOR

AUGMENTATION WELL PROJECT – DRILLING, DEVELOPMENT, AND TESTING

Notice is hereby given that Rancho Murieta Community Services District (District or Owner) invites sealed bids for the AUGMENTATION WELL PROJECT – DRILLING, DEVELOPMENT, AND TESTING at Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California. Sealed bids will be received until **11:30 a.m., July 21, 2017**. Award of project to successful bidder is predicated on District obtaining Right-of-Entry or ownership of site on which well is to be drilled.

The details and specifics related to the submission of a proposal can be found on the District's website, www.rmcsd.com, Request for Proposal #2017-02.

Work consists of drilling, development, and testing of one potable water well and the related improvements as described in the bid documents. These specifications are written for the well designated as well "PW-B", 30" conductor borehole, borehole depth of 350'. This is a prevailing wage job.

Each bid shall be made on the Bid Form provided in the Contract Documents and shall be sealed in a separate envelope with the bidder's name and the title of the Project on the outside. The sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed to **District Secretary, Rancho Murieta Community Services District, P. O. Box 1050, Rancho Murieta, California 95683**. Faxed or electronically submitted bids will not be accepted.

The District's right is reserved to reject all bids. Any bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents may be rejected. At any time prior to bid opening, the Owner may issue addenda to the specifications. The receipt of any addenda shall be noted on the bid and will become part of the Contract Documents.

In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code Section 3300, the District has determined that the Contractor must possess a valid California State Class C57 – Well Drilling Contractor's License at the time that the Contract is awarded and throughout the Contract's duration. Failure to possess the specified license shall render the bid as non-responsive, and shall act as a bar to award the Contract to any bidder not possessing said license at the time of award.
