ORDINANCE NO. 88-8

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE DISTRICT CODE RELATING TO WATER SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

The Water Code, Chapter 14 of the District Code, is amended in part as follows:

SECTION 7.08 WATER STANDBY OR AVAILABILITY CHARGE

The District may fix, on or before the first day of July in each calendar year and may annually collect a water standby or availability charge not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) per year for each acre of land, or ten dollars (\$10.00) per year for each parcel of land of less than an acre within the District to which water is made available for any purpose by the District, whether the water is actually used or not. The District may establish schedules varying the charges depending upon factors such as the use to which the land is put, the cost of transporting the water to the land, and the amount of water used by the land.

SECTION 7.09 FEES FOR LINE EXTENSION APPLICATIONS AND PLAN REVIEWS.

Fees for line extension applications, plan reviews, and construction inspection shall be as established by the General Manager, based upon the reasonable costs of providing the service.

SECTION 7.10 RATES FOR USE OF UNTREATED WATER.

The charge for untreated water shall be the $\underline{\text{sum}}$ of each of the following four categories of charges, as applicable:

- (a) For use of untreated water pumped from storage in Calero Reservoir: \$38.16 per acre foot.
- (b) For water delivered by the District to its customers by means of the Cosumnes Irrigation Association Canal:

Base rate [Includes 375,000 cu ft.]

\$150.00/month

Volumetric rate
[After first 375,000 cu ft.]

\$.04/100 cu ft.

(c) Water delivered from Bass Lake:

\$40.00 per month

(d) Water delivered from Laguna Joaquin:

Base rate

[Includes first 650,000 cu ft.] \$400.00/month

Volumetric rate

[After first 650,000 cu ft.] \$.06/100 cu ft.

The rates referred to in this ordinance do not reflect any increase, decrease or modification in rates. This ordinance is to correct a clerical error in the District Code.

SECTION THREE: To the extent the terms and provisions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the subject matter hereof and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: The identification and clarification of the fees, rates and charges set forth in Section One hereof, are for the purpose of continuing to provide funds to meet the District's cost of operation and maintenance, supply and equipment, financial reserve, debt service and capital replacement needs, and are necessary to maintain and improve service within the District's existing service boundaries.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall be published within 10 days of adoption in a newspaper of general circulation published within the District. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1989.
